- Document Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, Conflict of Interest, and Indemnification policies.
- Establish board manuals, onboarding processes, assessments, recruitment strategies, and meeting procedures.

Human Resources & Internal Policy

- Create written HR policies, job descriptions, and orientation processes.
- Implement performance review systems to support staff and volunteers.
- Ensure onboarding processes are consistent and documented.

Program & Service Management

- Provide comprehensive training for staff and volunteers.
- Continuously refine policies and procedures.
- Collaborate with external organizations to enhance service delivery.

Safety, Boundaries & Emergency Preparedness

- Define clear codes of conduct for staff and clients.
- Tailor program boundaries to fit your organization's unique mission.
- Prepare volunteer/staff applications, interview guides, background checks, and facility access protocols.
- Establish emergency procedures, training supervision, and discipline protocols.
